Consumer Law

Care's Consumer Law provides free legal assistance in the areas of consumer law and financial abuse for people in the ACT.

We offer advice in the following areas of law:

- consumer law guarantees and protections
- disputes about contracts for sale of goods and services
- consumer credit and debt including:
 - banking and credit disputes
 - credit contracts and consumer leases
 - telco and utility provider disputes
 - 'buy now-pay later' and payday lenders
 - car finance
- insurance and bankruptcy.

We also operate the Defined Benefit Information Service (DBIS) for the Motor Accident Injuries Commission, which provides information and limited legal advice on the ACT's Motor Accident Insurance Scheme.

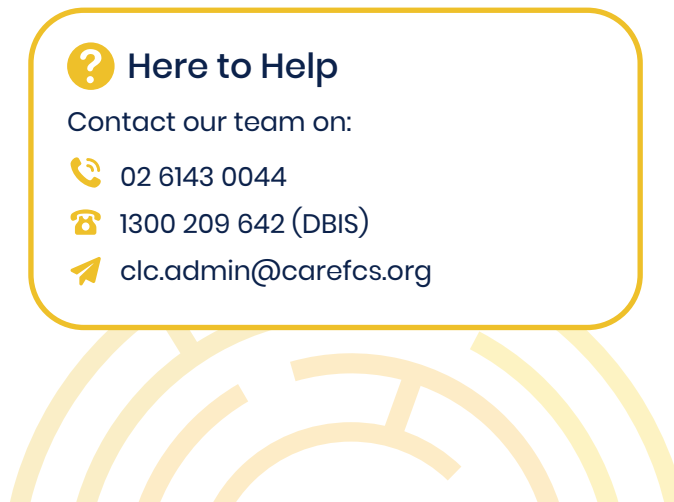

Care's Community Loans provides 0% interest loans for low to moderate income earners. These loans are up to \$1500 and can be used to purchase or pay for:

- essential household items
- whitegoods
- electronic devices
- car repairs and registration
- medical/dental costs
- educational expenses and more.

We also have a dedicated program (Assistance Beyond Crisis) for people who have experienced and left a domestic or family violence situation.
